



Professor Pantaleo M. D. Rwelamila – Profile

P. D. Rwelamila is currently a South African National Research Foundation (NRF) rated researcher and Professor of Project Management and Procurement in the School of Business Leadership, University of South Africa (UNISA). He formally taught at University of Zambia and Copper Belt University in Zambia, University of Botswana and University of Cape Town in South Africa. Professor Rwelamila has also taught during short periods in several universities including: The Royal Institute of Technology in Sweden; University of Manchester, University of West of England and University of Bath in the United Kingdom; Queensland University of Technology in Australia; and Heriott Watt University – Dubai Campus. He has also held University governance roles as Head of Department.

Professor Rwelamila is currently also a non-executive Director and board chairman of Msingi Construction Project Management (Pty) Ltd – a construction project management company based in Cape Town; co-owner and director of Built Environment Management Consultants (BEMC) (Pty) Ltd, based in Gaborone, Botswana; and joint co-ordinator: CIB W107 – Construction in Developing Countries.

Professor Rwelamila has also been a senior consultant for a number of country and international organisations, including Swedish International Development Agency (SIDA), International Labour Organisation (ILO), Shelter Afrique – African Development Bank (ADB) affiliated organisation in Kenya, and a number of construction industry based in South Africa.

Professor Rwelamila is an author of more than 200 peer reviewed journal and conference proceeding publications, research and study reports. He has been involved in high level public assignments in South Africa, including the development of South African Construction Industry Policy through the Department of Public Works (DPW) as infrastructure cluster lead Department.

His main research areas lie in broad academic areas of Supply Chain Management, Project Management (across industries), Procurement systems, Construction Industry Development and Small Business Development.

Professor Rwelamila is Past President: The South African Council for Project and Construction Management Professions (SACPCMP) (2005 -2009); and Past Vice President, Chartered Institute of Building (Africa). In 2005 at the CIB W92 Conference -University of Arizona, USA, Professor Rwelamila was named as the second most cited researcher in project procurement in the world.

Professor Rwelamila is on the editorial board of several international journals, including *the Journal of Construction in Developing Countries*, *Journal of Place Management and Development*, *Journal of Environmental Management and Safety*, *Journal of Building and Land Development*, *The Open Construction and Building Technology Journal*, *The Journal of Education in the Built Environment* and *Botswana Journal of Technology*. He is also the Africa region Editor, *Built Environment and Project Asset Management (BEPAM) Journal*.
